### **BARSTOW VILLAGE, HANOVER, MA**

There will be a representative from Barstow Village here at St. Mary's after our 4PM Mass on October 23<sup>rd</sup> for those interested in the new housing community.

Construction has begun on Barstow Village, a new senior 62+ community in Hanover which should be ready for occupancy, Spring, 2012. Applications are currently being accepted through December 9th. The initial selection for these units will be done by Lottery which will take place on December 16th at 9:00 a.m. at the Hanover Town Hall. Eligibility for renting is determined by income and based on either the 30%, 50% or 60% of AMI formula (area median income). The rent range is between \$489 and \$1031 for a one bedroom and for a two bedroom, \$1249 with heat and hot water included. Supportive services and coordinated activities will be available to help promote an independent living environment and, management staff will be located on-site. The building offers amenities such as community center, on-site laundry care center, secured entry access, pet friendly and with outdoor patio and BBQ area.

In particular for Hanover residents faced with either staying where they are or moving away from their families, churches and the community, Barstow Village is the perfect solution.

Sending in an application could be the first step toward moving into a new, affordable home.

# THIRD EDITION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL

## **Beginning the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011, the Church will implement the Third Edition of the Roman Missal.**

We encourage our parishioners to be attentive to these changes now so that we as a community can continue to pray as one voice going forward. The new responses will be used at all Masses including Sundays, Funeral Liturgies, Weddings, Confirmation, First Communion, etc. It is our desire to reach as many people as possible to prepare to first understand the importance and meaning of the new words and to then fulfill our role as people who enter into “full, active, conscious participation” in the liturgy.

### **Where can I find more information about the New Roman Missal?**

We will be publishing the new texts in the bulletin with short explanations explaining the change in the weeks before its implementation on the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011.

There is a laminated card in each pew with the new responses.  
If you stop by to make a visit in the church during the week please take a moment to read them.

Most importantly, we are offering “**Lifting Our Hearts**” a six session opportunity to pray with and grow to appreciate and embrace the new responses.
