# MINISTRY CORNER

## **GREETER MINISTRY**

**Ministry Head: Kelle Puleo**

“Everyone in the parish is a Minister of 1st Impression.”

A smile and a warm “Hello” can do wonders for someone “new to the parish or just visiting!” People experience the presence of Jesus Christ in the world through the ministry of the Church. The first task of the parish community is to reach out to all the people in love and Christian service, to “extend hospitality to the stranger in our midst.” (Roman 12:13b) Christian hospitality draws people together, opens them to participation, and sets the tone for the liturgy. We strive to be a welcoming parish! If you love to meet people, this is the ministry for you.

Those who serve as Greeters should be faithful members of the Church and active members of the parish community. They should feel comfortable meeting and greeting people and take their example and their affirmation from Matthew 23:35-36. “Then the king will say to those on his right, “Come, you who are blessed by my Father.” Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.

### **Time Responsibility:**

Arrive 30 minutes early for Mass to greet people and direct people with any questions or special needs. Be present after Mass to provide bulletins and information as people are leaving.

## **USHER MINISTRY**

**(Ministry Head: Joe Harrington)**

Ushers play an especially important role in the parish. Like the Apostles, the ushers help to lead people to Christ by guiding them into the worship space, conscious of their needs in order to hear and see. An usher should feel comfortable asking people to slide in to make room for others who wait to be seated or who need seating close to the altar for the easy reception of the Eucharist.

It is the Ushers job not only to guide people into the worship space, and to collect the offertory, bringing forth the temporal goods of the people for the greater glory of God, but also to assure that everything is ready for the celebration of the Mass, the reason we are all there. In large measure, the ushers set the stage for what will follow. Is there a clear path to the tabernacle or are there people standing in front that need to be seated?? Is it too warm/cold? When everything goes well, people are comfortable and not distracted by environmental issues. An effective usher is sensitive to the needs of the gathered community while maintaining a reverence and awe of the liturgy. During Mass, Ushers are, too, a part of the worshipping community.

### **Time Responsibility:**

Arrive 30 minutes prior to Mass.

## **ANNOUNCER MINISTRY**

**(Ministry Head: John Murray)**

Announcers help to prepare the congregation to enter the celebration of the Liturgy by welcoming the congregation “especially those who are attending St. Mary’s for the first time.” and inviting us to feel more at home by directing us to the Greeters who can assist us following Mass. The Announcer also gives directive for the reception of Communion and invites us to greet our brothers and sisters “in a spirit of Christian fellowship.”

### **Time Responsibility:**

Announcers should arrive 15 minutes before Mass begins.
