INFORMATION ABOUT THE PETITION DRIVE FOR ASSISTED SUICIDE

THIRD EDITION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL

Beginning the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011, the Church will implement the Third Edition of the Roman Missal.

We encourage our parishioners to be attentive to these changes now so that we as a community can continue to pray as one voice going forward. The new responses will be used at all Masses including Sundays, Funeral Liturgies, Weddings, Confirmation, First Communion, etc. It is our desire to reach as many people as possible to prepare to first understand the importance and meaning of the new words and to then fulfill our role as people who enter into “full, active, conscious participation” in the liturgy.

We recently introduced Memorial Acclamation C

“Save us, Savior of the world, for by your cross and resurrection you have set us free.”

The Memorial Acclamation (Anamnesis) recalls the saving power of Christ’s Passion.

When we sing, or say, this acclamation in one voice, we, as a parish community in Hanover, MA, join our voices with those of Catholics around the world who profess the saving power of Christ.
