The Eucharist is the summit toward which the ministerings of all the lay liturgical ministers has led, the moment when our every day actions and experiences are transcended and we achieve total union between heaven and earth. We have journeyed together and now come to recognize Jesus in the breaking of the Bread. We come to receive that which we have become.

The demeanor of the extraordinary minister of the Eucharist reflects the sacredness of the moment. The extraordinary minister of the Eucharist approaches the altar reverently and without haste to receive from the hands of the priest the Body and Blood of Christ that will be distributed to the gathered faithful.

One's exterior disposition should reflect one's interior disposition. In other words, those who distribute the body and blood of Christ should reflect the Church's belief in the actual, real, and true presence of the Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Each minister should make eye contact with those who come forward for the sacrament. Additionally, and most importantly, there should be direct address and uniformity of blessing: The Body of Christ. The Blood of Christ.
