Our Lenten journey is nearing an end. We are at the beginning of the most solemn week in our Church calendar. Some people joined us six weeks ago on Ash Wednesday and perhaps there are people here today who have not been with us each week. It is good for us to be together! How much better our observance of Lent would have been if everyone who came for ashes and everyone who is here for palms, was with us each week! And how much better our celebration of the Easter season will be (not just one day but a *whole season*) and beyond, if we gather here to worship God and give thanks for the blessings in our lives *each week*.

The prophet Isaiah says: "The Lord GOD has given me a well-trained tongue, that I might know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them." We pray that each of us will be open to the working of the Holy Spirit within us, that each of us will develop a well-trained tongue that will rouse the weary and invite and welcome people home to the practice of the faith. **ABSTINENCE**—Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence. Abstinence is to be observed on all Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be used at all.

**FAST**—Catholics over 18 and up to the beginning of their 60<sup>th</sup> year are bound to the obligation of fasting. **Good Friday, April 22nd** -----a day of fasting. On this day, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed.

Regarding other weekdays of Lent, participation in daily Mass and the voluntary observance of fasting is recommended.

Commendable, particularly during Lent, is generosity to local, national and world programs of sharing our abundance, the traditional Lenten Devotions, and all the self denial summed up in the Christian concept of "mortification."
