HOLY WEEK REGULATIONS

Good Friday is a day of Fast and Abstinence. Catholics over the age of 18 and up to 60 are bound to the obligation of fast. One full meal is allowed. Catholics over the age of 14 through the beginning of their 60th Year are bound to the obligation of abstinence. Meat may not be used at all.
