Thought for the week

It is easy to say we believe in God, we believe in Jesus, but putting that faith into practice is not so easy. When we think of God “speaking:” to us, we think of a loud booming voice from the sky, but in this week’s readings Elijah hears a “tiny, whispering sound” and has faith that it is God’s voice telling him he will be safe and protected.

In the Gospel, we find the disciples out in a boat in a storm, and Jesus walks on the water to calm and save them. Then Peter tries to walk on the water to Jesus, but does not have the faith he needs and begins to sink. We need to remember that God is always with us, and will always help us if we believe he will. His help may not come in the way we would expect, or even the way we want sometimes, but he will always help.

This week, when you are having trouble with something, quiet your head and your heart and just listen. Maybe you will hear that “tiny, whispering sound” that will help you sort out your difficulty. Remember, if you have faith, God will lead you in the right direction.
